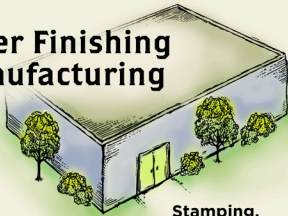

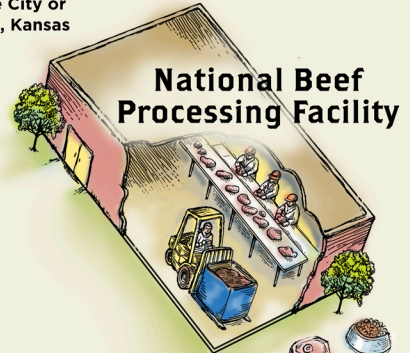

REFUSE

Any material that can only be disposed of (provided disposal is safe and legal).



RECYCLE

Material that can be made into other products.



REDUCE

The amount of resources used such as energy, water, chrome, etc.



RECOVER

Raw materials (i.e. heat energy for example from oils or solvents that cannot be recycled).



REUSE

Material for the same purpose without additional input like wastewater, pallets, chrome, etc.
